Responsibilities

Reporting to the Youth Residential Supervisor, the Home Supervisor will oversee the day to day activities of the group home. Responsibilities of the Home Supervisor could include scheduling, communicating with families and guardians, supervision of front-line staff, providing orientation and evaluations, and responding to crisis situations as required.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Two year diploma in a related field (e.g. Human Services, Social Work, Psychology etc.) or a degree from a **recognized** post-secondary institution is **required**
- One year of experience working with developmental disabilities and/or mental health challenges
- One year of supervisory experience required
- Experience providing behavioural supports to clients
- Experience providing personal care (e.g. assisting with bathing or toileting and personal hygiene)
- Access to a personal vehicle is required

Compensation

The wage for this position is based on education and experience and ranges from \$20.97-\$22.03/hour. We also offer a competitive benefits package for full-time Home Supervisor positions.
